Les Têtes de l'Art

MARSEILLE, FRANCE

During the first part of the event, there was a strong focus on two specific elements of the project: the MOOC and the festival and their significance within the context of the project.

In the second part, to provide more insight into the project, we invited a guest speaker, Pierre Tremerele, who shared his experience in developing Module 3 with a group of participants.

The multiplier event proved to be an effective catalyst in increasing the participants' level of engagement and motivation to enroll in the MOOC, as well as to submit their respective documentary proposals.



SMouTh (Greece)

LARISSA, GREECE

The multiplier event in Larissa, Greece focused on adult education and community building. The event included a discussion on the importance of social documentary as an educational tool and its potential to make adult education more attractive by **using** the creativity of learners, as well as presentations of the ENACTING MOOC platform. There was also a presentation on social documentary and community building, featuring speakers from the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, the Municipal Youth Council of Larissa, the University of Citizens of Larissa and "i-living". The event concluded with a short video from the ROOTS&ROUTES to highlight the importance of international youth mobility in the development of creativity and social change at local





DRESDEN, GERMANY

JKPeV (Germany)

Three ENACTING multiplier events were held at KulturCentrale and aimed at sharing the project's results with a wider audience, including local community members, artists and individuals active in the field of CCS. The events featured film workshops, project presentations, and public screenings of social documentaries for example by **the** local filmmaker Martin Zech. **The film makers and trainers, Olga Yocheva and Augusto Gerardi showed presented the basics of producing a social documentary and shared with the participants some interview techniques.** The ENACTING project presentation encouraged participants to register for the **ENACTING online course** and share their ideas on current social issues through the ENACTING Participatory Media Lab.



FLORENCE, ITALY

CCC (Italy)

The first multiplier event was organised by CCC in collaboration with the Europe Direct and InformaGiovani desks of the Florence Municipality. The second multiplier event was organised in Sesto Fiorentino (Florence) in collaboration with the public library Biblioteca E. Ragionieri and with Macramè Cooperativa Sociale.

Both events featured a presentation of the ENACTING project, **the Online Course, the Participatory Media Lab** and the Digital Festival, and actively involved the audience in workshop practices led by Marina Arienza. A third multiplier event will take place on April 30th at PARC Performing Arts Research Centre in collaboration with Edera cultural association and monthly magazine.
